

All residents in Trinity County should have received a pink Residency Notification postcard. Please review your physical and mailing addresses listed. If all of your information is CORRECT you may DISREGARD the notice and your registration information will remain the same. If you need to make changes to your information, note those corrections in the boxes at the bottom of the card, sign, date and return it to the Elections office as soon as possible.

Voters who are registered as No Party Preference (NPP) should have received an additional white postcard to inform them of their crossover voting options.

If you are registered WITHOUT a political party (No Party Preference) you will not have the Presidential race on our ballot. If you want to vote for a Presidential Candidate within the American Independent, Democratic, or Libertarian parties you will need to complete & return the white postcard as soon as possible. These are the only parties allowing crossover voting. If you do not respond, you will receive a ballot that does not include candidates for President.

If you would like to vote for a Presidential Candidate within the Green, Peace & Freedom, or Republican parties you must re-register. You should re-register as soon as possible but no later than **February 19, 2023**.
