Hi Bella,

I received these documents from Lisa Wrenn and Chris Losi. Chris is on leave until August 3rd- I am Acting Ranger today and tomorrow while David Schmerge will be Acting for the month of July. We don't have the ability to edit/add comments to the pdfs but our comments and questions are below.

The following are comments for CCV-20-12 Buell:

- No water shall be diverted from National Forest System lands;
- No access from National Forest System lands because landowner has access from Morgan Hill Road;
- Appears that they are using a loop road shown on the Site Map that generates from National Forest System
 lands which is not authorized and the County should not allow them to use it because they have access from
 Morgan Hill Road.
- Appears from the Site Map that some of the improvements may be on National Forest System lands. Does the
 county have a land survey of the property to determine if this is indeed the case? If so, please provide this
 information to Chris Losi at Christopher.losi@usda.gov and Carla De Juilio (carla.dejuilio@usda.gov)
- No cultivation shall occur on National Forest System lands.
- The Biological Resources section states that there are known candidate, sensitive or species status species located on or near the project site. Could you provide us with Attachment 4-d that is mentioned there. I am curious what species.

The following are comments for CCV-20-14 Dobo:

- No water shall be diverted from National Forest System lands;
- No access from National Forest System lands because landowner has access from within the surrounding area;
- No cultivation shall occur on National Forest System lands.
