NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Election will be held in the Mountain Communities Healthcare District on TUESDAY, June 7, 2011, to submit to the voters in the Mountain Communities Healthcare District the following measure:

MEASURE T

“24 HOUR EMERGENCY ROOM/TRINITY HOSPITAL MEASURE. To keep Trinity Hospital and its emergency room open, ensure residents 24-hour access to a doctor on duty, and maintain additional locally-based healthcare services throughout the District, shall Mountain Communities Healthcare District continue but not increase its existing parcel tax at the rate of \$32 per undeveloped parcel, or \$118 per dwelling unit or improved nonresidential parcel annually, with independent audits, public fiscal oversight, and expiring in 5 years?”

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that written arguments may be submitted to the Trinity County Clerk for or against the ballot measure.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that arguments shall not exceed 300 words in length, and must be submitted to the County Clerk at his office at 11 Court Street, PO Box 1215, Weaverville, CA 96093 no later than 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 6, 2011. Arguments that have been submitted may be changed up until the filing deadline.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that if more than one argument for or more that one argument against each measure is submitted by the filing deadline, the County Clerk will select one argument for and one argument against each measure to be printed and distributed to the voters and he will send a copy of the argument in favor and a copy of the argument against each measure to the author(s) of the argument in favor of each measure. The authors may prepare and submit a rebuttal argument not to exceed 250 words in length. Rebuttal arguments must be filed no later than 4:00 p.m. on Monday, April 18, 2011. In selecting arguments to be printed, the County Clerk shall give preference and priority in the order named to the arguments of the following, pursuant to Elections Code Section 9166.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the polls at said election will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
