

Trinity County Road Name Request Form

Trinity County Emergency Response network utilizes street addresses for location identification. It is very important to name roads, but at the same time not to duplicate road names or use similar road names in the same area.

The County will circulate this form to appropriate agencies for review, post a public notice and route this request to allow for public comments on proposed names, and submit to the Board of Supervisors for approval. Applicants are responsible for purchasing, installing and maintaining private road signs after a name is approved. An encroachment permit may be required from the Department of Transportation or Caltrans prior to placing a new private road sign.

Please list below at least three (2) names for consideration. Try to select names consisting of less than 12 letters, not including letters used for "Road, Street, Lane, Avenue", which will be abbreviated. LIST NAMES IN ORDER OF PREFERENCE. To assist reviewing agencies in identifying the correct location of the subject road, provide a map of the vicinity and location of the road to be named or renamed.
