Press Release River Complex - Major Disaster Declaration

Trinity County (November 22, 2021) – The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has approved the request by the Trinity County Office of Emergency Services and the California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) to include the River Complex in the major disaster declaration for the 2021 wildfires in Trinity County.

Individuals, governmental entities, and eligible private non-profits impacted by the River Complex in Trinity County are now eligible for both FEMA Individual Assistance/Public Assistance and Small Business Administration (SBA) Disaster Assistance under FEMA-4610-DR-CA.

Although the deadline to register with FEMA/SBA closed on November 8, 2021, those impacted by the River Complex are still able to register with FEMA by calling 1-800-621-FEMA (1-800-621-3362) and with SBA by calling 1-800-659-2955.

Those impacted by the River Complex should inform FEMA/SBA that they are registering late because the River Complex was added to DR-4610 after the November 8, 2021 registration deadline. The deadline for those impacted by the River Complex to register with FEMA/SBA has been extended to January 8, 2022.
