Project Title: Lance Gulch Road/State Route 299 Intersection Control Project

State Clearinghouse Number: 2016092063

Project Location: Intersection of SR 299, Lance Gulch Road and Glen Road in Weaverville, Trinity County, California.

Project Description: Construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Lance Gulch Road and State Route (SR) 299. Additionally, a new opening to Nugget Lane from SR 299 would be constructed. The intersection was originally planned as a signalized intersection as part of the East Connector Roadway Project, and the signalized intersection remains the “no project alternative”.

This is to advise that the Trinity County Board of Supervisors, as lead agency, has approved the above-described project on June 1, 2017 and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:

1. As mitigated, the project [will will not] have a significant effect on the environment.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA, and certified by the Trinity County Board of Supervisors.
 A Negative Declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation Measures [were were not] made a condition of the approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan [was was not] adopted for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations [was was not] adopted for this project.
6. The following Finding was made by the Trinity County Board of Supervisors:
"On the basis of the whole record including the initial study, comments received, and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant effect on the environment and that a mitigated negative declaration reflects the Board's independent judgment and analysis."
