

Voting in Trinity County for the November 3, 2020 Election

Every active registered voter will receive a Vote-By-Mail (Absentee) ballot. There will not be Polling places for this election. There will be one Voter Assistance Center at the Trinity County Courthouse 11 Court Street, Weaverville, CA where you can obtain a replacement ballot, drop off your voted ballot, register to vote or vote an accessible ballot on a tablet.

- All ballots received are counted, even if a contest is close.
- Don't want to vote all contests; vote the ones you do and those will count.
- Return your voted ballot in your (pre-paid First-Class Postage) envelope to the Post Office or one of the Secure Ballot Drop Boxes.
- If you need a replacement ballot contact the office.
- All signatures are compared to all signatures on file.
- If your signature doesn't match, you will be contacted and given an opportunity to correct it.
