

IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS BY COUNTY COUNSEL

COUNTY OF TRINITY MEASURE “L”

This Measure contains a proposed amendment to Chapter 3.28 of the Trinity County Municipal Code with respect to the County’s transient occupancy tax (“TOT”). This tax is only charged to persons staying at hotels within the County, who are primarily out of town visitors to the County. The current TOT rate is five percent (5%) of the room rate charged by the hotel operators. This measure would add an additional five percent (5%) tax to the room rate charged by the hotel operators, for a total of ten percent (10%).

This additional five percent (5%) tax is being proposed as a general tax. The increase must be approved by a majority (50+1) vote of the voters of Trinity County.

A “yes” vote will increase the TOT from 5% to 10%.

A “no” vote will keep the TOT at 5%.

This measure is placed on the ballot by Board of Supervisors of the County.
