Press Release COVID-19 Testing

Trinity County, CA – In order to make COVID-19 testing more widely available in Trinity County, county staff will be making Let's Get Checked COVID-19 (self-administered) test kits available at locations around the county. Let's Get Checked test kits require a gentle lower nasal swab. Samples are returned to the lab via UPS, and test results are delivered via email typically within 24-72 hours. County staff are available to assist with registration and kit activation and will transport samples to a UPS drop off location as requested during scheduled locations and times.
