SUBJECT: New Protocols for Requesting and Scheduling Inspections

Dear Program Applicants and Consultants:

In order to more efficiently and effectively schedule and perform inspections, the Division has now set certain days our Compliance Staff will be in certain areas of the County and staff must have at least a minimum of 3-4 confirmed inspections to go out on inspections for any given day. More than 4 inspections per day will be scheduled whenever possible.

In order to best facilitate this new policy, applicants and consultants are to reach out to our office via phone, email or stop by our office during normal business hours to let us know that they are available for inspections at this time. We will be prioritizing Phase I, II & III applicants.

24-hour notice will be provided to applicants and their authorized agent via email, phone or at the counter and confirmation of appointment time is required. Please keep in mind that an inspection is required prior to license issuance.
