

# Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC)

## SUBCOMMITTEE MEMBERS WANTED

The Trinity County Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC) is seeking individuals who are interested in volunteering to apply for an open position on a subcommittee being created to voice their thoughts and assist in developing a plan to provide appropriate rehabilitation and supervision services for youth who previously were eligible to be committed to the Department of Juvenile Justice.

Subcommittee members must be individuals who have experience providing community-based youth services, youth justice advocates with expertise and knowledge of the juvenile justice system, or have been directly involved in the juvenile justice system.

Detailed information can be found in the California Welfare and Institutions Code within Sections 1990, 1991 and 1995.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The JJCC is a multiagency council responsible for the development and implementation of a continuum of county-based responses to juvenile crime. The coordinating council includes the chief probation officer, as chair, and one representative each from the district attorney's office, the public defender's office, the sheriff's department, the board of supervisors, the department of social services, the department of mental health, a community-based drug and alcohol program, the county office of education or a school district, and an at-large community representative.
