RESCISSION OF ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER DATE OF RESCISSION: November 4, 2021

Effective immediately, the Trinity County Health Officer Order FOR MANDATORY USE OF FACE COVERINGS IN WORKPLACES AND PUBLIC SETTINGS, dated August 26, 2021, requiring all persons to wear face coverings while inside indoor public settings located in Trinity County ("County"), regardless of whether or not they have been fully vaccinated against Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19"), unless specifically exempted from the face covering requirement is rescinded in full.

Individuals should continue to follow masking requirements and other guidance released by the California Department of Public Health ("CDPH"):

Masks are required for all individuals in the following indoor settings, regardless of vaccination status:

- *On public transit (examples: airplanes, ships, ferries, trains, subways, buses, taxis, and ride-shares) and in transportation hubs (examples: airport, bus terminal, marina, train station, seaport or other port, subway station, or any other area that provides transportation)*
- *Indoors in K-12 schools, childcare*
- *Emergency shelters and cooling centers*

Masks are required for all individuals, in the following indoor settings, regardless of vaccination status (and surgical masks are recommended):

- *Healthcare settings*
- *State and local correctional facilities and detention centers*
- *Homeless shelters*
- *Long Term Care Settings & Adult and Senior Care Facilities*

Additionally, masks are required for unvaccinated individuals in indoor public settings and businesses (examples: retail, restaurants, theaters, family entertainment centers, meetings, state and local government offices serving the public).*
