Trinity County Coronavirus (COVID-19) Health Advisory

TRINITY COUNTY – Trinity County Public Health Branch (TCPHB), through Case Investigation over the weekend, has identified the following potential sources of exposure:

- 12/12/2020 - Winco Redding on 1050 Old Alturas Rd, Redding, CA 96003
- 12/13/20 - Holiday Market on 1665 Main St, Weaverville, CA 96093
- 12/13/20 - Dollar General on 1100 Main St, Weaverville, CA 96093

We ask the public to monitor for the following symptoms:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If you develop symptoms please self-isolate and contact your healthcare provider and obtain testing. We also ask any persons who believe they may have been exposed to get tested and self-quarantine.

Trinity County remains in the Purple Tier (widespread). Here is what we know:

- Hospitals throughout California are severely impacted, limiting the number of Intensive Care Unit (ICU) beds available in the state
- The second COVID-19 Vaccine by Moderna has been issued an Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Information on the Moderna vaccine EUA can be found here:

- The following is recommended to prevent further spread throughout Trinity County:
 - Proper social distancing of at least 6 feet
 - Masking or Face shield at all times when out in public
 - Increased ventilation – outdoor versus indoor and adequate air flow in buildings prevents spread when all other preventative measures above are implemented
 - Frequent hand-washing and sanitizing high-touch surfaces
 - Self-isolate if develop any symptoms consistent with COVID-19
 - Self-quarantine if exposed
 - Get tested
 - Get vaccinated as soon as it is available to you
