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### Trinity County Coronavirus (COVID-19) Health Advisory

TRINITY COUNTY – On January 12, 2021, with the recent decline in case and test positivity rates, Trinity County has moved into the Blueprint Red Tier. All sectors should refer to the Blueprint for a Safer Economy page on the COVID-19 state website for the guidance under the Red Tier at <https://covid19.ca.gov/safer-economy/>

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) conducts weekly assessment of county case and test positivity trends, if our adjusted case rate and/or test positivity has fallen within a less restrictive tier for two consecutive weekly periods, Trinity County can revert to the less restrictive tier. The following changes to sectors from Purple to Red Tier include but are not limited to:

- Restaurants:
  - Indoor with modifications
  - Capacity must be limited to 25% or 100 people, whichever is less
- Wineries and tasting rooms outdoor only with modifications
- Bars, breweries, and distilleries (where no meals are served) remain closed



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- Retail
  - Open with modifications
  - Retail capacity must be limited to 50%
  
- Places of Worship
  - indoor with modifications
  - Indoor activities must be limited to 25% of capacity or 100 people, whichever is less
  
- Hotels, Resorts, Lodging Entities
  - Open with modifications
  - Fitness centers can open to 10% capacity
  - Indoor pools, hot tubs, saunas, and steam rooms must close
    - Drowning prevention classes, including swim lessons with certified instructors, are permitted in indoor and outdoor swimming pools in all tiers, as they are deemed essential
  
- Gyms and Fitness Centers
  - Indoor with modifications
  - Capacity must be limited to 10%
  - Indoor pools, hot tubs, saunas, and steam rooms must close
    - Drowning prevention classes, including swim lessons with certified instructors, are permitted in indoor and outdoor swimming pools in all tiers, as they are deemed essential
  - Climbing walls can open
  
- Limited Stay at Home Order Does Not Apply Once Out of the Purple Tier
  - Not Applicable i.e., persons do not need to in home by 10:00 PM and stay home until 5:00 AM
