COVID-19 Community Based Testing Continues into July

Trinity County – Trinity County Health and Human Services (HHS) Public Health Branch (PHB) and its partners from the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Testing Task Force and Verily Life Sciences continue to conduct COVID-19 Testing in the areas of Hayfork, Weaverville, and Willow Creek. Over the last three (3) weeks, the mobile COVID-19 testing has resulted in the testing of 239 individuals. To continue to ensure broad testing access for all Trinity County residents, drive-thru testing will continue according to the following schedule:

- Thursday, June 25th, 2020 8:00 am – 11:45 am, Trinity Alps Performing Arts Center, 1010 Arbuckle Court, Weaverville
- Friday, June 26th, 2020 9:00 am – 2:00 pm, Big Rock Day Use Area, 2383-2405 Trinity River Hwy, Willow Creek
- Thursday, July 2nd, 2020 8:00 am-11:45 am, Trinity Alps Performing Arts Center, 101 Arbuckle Court, Weaverville
- Thursday, July 9th, 2020 8:00 am-11:45 am, Trinity Alps Performing Arts Center, 101 Arbuckle Court, Weaverville
- Friday, July 10th, 2020 9:00 am – 2:00 pm, Trinity County Fair Grounds, 6000 State Hwy 3, Hayfork

Individuals can now complete the online registration process, which includes creating a Google (“Gmail”) email account, completing the screening form and a short health insurance attestation. Verily will bill insurance for those that have healthcare coverage, there is no cost to the individual for testing whether or not they have health insurance. Once completed, individuals can make an appointment online using the Baseline COVID-19 Program appointment scheduling system found on our trinitycounty.org website or at www.projectbaseline.com/COVID19. Appointments are available for scheduling seven (7) days prior to the scheduled drive-thru site. After scheduling

This is a free testing service, and its purpose is to protect the public health and safety of our communities by allowing for increased surveillance of disease activity in Trinity County and ensure broad access to testing for all of our residents in Trinity County. Eligibility for free testing is as follows:

- persons must be 18 years of age or older
- must electronically complete the Screening Form
- Sign the COVID-19 Public Health Authorization form and Lab consent.

All client information is kept confidential under the law.
