

Trinity County Jail In-Custody Death Reporting

The information below is being provided in response to the passage of California Assembly Bill 2761.

In-Custody Death – January 14, 2024

On Sunday, January 14, 2024, a Trinity County Jail inmate housed at the Detention Facility died in Dorm A in Weaverville. The decedent is a 32-year-old White male who was awaiting arraignment. The manner and mode of death are still pending investigation.

In-Custody Death – January 8, 2024

On Monday, January 8, 2024, a Trinity County Jail inmate housed at the Detention Facility died in Dorm A in Weaverville. The decedent is a 35-year-old White male who was awaiting arraignment. The manner of death was suicide and the mode of death was Ligature Asphyxiation.

In-Custody Death – February 26, 2023

On Sunday, February 26, 2023, a Trinity County Jail inmate housed at the Detention Facility died in Dorm A in Weaverville. The decedent is a 44-year-old White male who was awaiting trial. The manner of death was suicide and the mode of death was Ligature Asphyxiation.
