All items will be inspected

Paper Items - Must be clean and dry

Newspaper
Junk Mail
Magazines
Books hard covers removed
Paper Bags
Cardboard (no waxed)
Egg Cartons (paper only)
File Folders - no staples or metal
Shredded Paper
Paper Reams
Sticky Notes
Office Paper (all colors) Envelopes
Telephone Books

Plastic Items - Must be clean and dry

Plastic Bags
All plastics #1 - #7
Plastic Lids & Tubs
Milk Jugs (rinsed)
Plastic Bottles (CRV* & Non-CRV)
Plastic Hangers

Glass - Must be clean and dry

Glass bottles (CRV* & Non-CRV)

Metal Items - Must be clean and dry

Aluminum Cans (CRV* & Non-CRV)
Bi-Steel Clean
All Food Cans (tuna, vegetable &
fruit, beans, soup, etc.) rinsed Clean

**You may prefer to take your aluminum, plastic, and glass CRV bottles to a Certified Recycler for cash.*

DO NOT PUT THESE ITEMS INTO THE COMPACTOR:

Food of any type, Hazardous or Biohazard waste,
Sharps or needles, Soiled paper towels,
Waxed Cardboard, Ice Cream containers,
Window glass, Mirrors,
Motor oil or filters,
Plastic chairs and tables

Diapers, Feminine Hygiene products
Kleenex, Used Paper plates
Antifreeze or Hazardous waste containers
Batteries, Light bulbs
Clothing or cloth
Toys
